DGM ANNOUNCES SALES OF NEW EQUIPMENT

Elizabethville, PA– Dauphin Graphic Machines, Inc. (DGM) announces the sale of eight (8) DGM 430 units to AFL Web Printing of Voorhees, New Jersey. Delivered at the end of July, the presses are expected to be fully commissioned by September 1, 2006. The DGM 430 units will be configured as two (2) four high towers with GMI ink presets and CC1 register control. This sale represents the 14th purchase of DGM equipment for AFL.

Home Mountain Publishing Company, Incorporated of Valparaiso, Indiana has purchased four (4) DGM 430 units and one (1) DGM 1035 folder. The equipment will be delivered mid September and is expected to be in use by mid October of this year. Celebrating their 100th anniversary this year, Home Mountain Publishing is a commercial printer that also publishes the *Catholic News* (17,000 circulation weekly) for the Gary, Indiana diocese, as well as Real Estate Guides and Shoppers. They will house the press in a new building, then move their other 2 presslines after the new DGM press is up and running.

Located in Elizabethville, PA, DGM employs 205 persons within a 125,000 square foot manufacturing facility. DGM Manufactures a complete line of single width offset presses including the DGM 430, DGM Advantage, DGM Advantage II (also a slip in replacement press for the DGM 850 or Urbanite™ DGM 440, DGM 440S, DGM 850, DGM 870 as well being the manufacturer of the Americolor tower, a 50" double width tower extension to the installed base. DGM also manufactures a full line of complimenting folders in the DGM 1035, DGM 1240, DGM 1050, DGM 1255, and the DGM 1270 jaw folder.
