**DGM ANNOUNCES SALES OF NEW EQUIPMENT TO  
NEW ZEALAND NEWSPAPER PUBLISHER**

Elizabethville, PA– Dauphin Graphic Machines, Inc. (DGM) announces the sale of DGM 430 printing units to *The Marlborough Express* of Blenheim, New Zealand.

The press system purchase includes three (3) DGM 430 four-high towers, which will replace four existing Goss® community units, and adding to their existing press line. *The Marlborough Express* has a daily circulation of 11,000. The DGM press will also print various weekly and semi-commercial jobs.

Installation of the DGM 430 press will be in two phases, with two towers installed by mid-July, and Phase II to be installed sometime by mid-September. The press is expected to be running by the end of September of this year.

DGM agent Webco Ltd. of New Zealand handled the sale. “Webco is not only a good sales partner for DGM, but can also handle installation, rebuilding, and most importantly, parts and service support for all of our product lines”, notes Ron Ehrhardt, DGM Vice President of International Sales. Webco Ltd. has sold a total of 44 DGM 430 units into New Zealand for DGM.

Located in Elizabethville, PA, DGM employs 205 persons within a 125,000 square foot manufacturing facility. DGM Manufactures a complete line of single width offset presses including the DGM 430, DGM Advantage, DGM Advantage II

(also a slip in replacement press for the DGM 850 or Urbanite™ DGM 440, DGM 440S, DGM 850, DGM 870 as well being the manufacturer of the Americolor tower, a 50" double width tower extension to the installed base. DGM also manufactures a full line of complimenting folders in the DGM 1035, DGM 1240, DGM 1050, DGM 1255, and the DGM 1270 jaw folder.
